Curriculum Coverage

Children are taught Mathematics through a Mastery approach to learning following the National Curriculum.

Children are taught English following the National Curriculum. Within English lesson children cover a wide range of genres and will be taught grammar, spelling and reading skills throughout the lessons.

Children have weekly lessons on Science, Computing, French, Music, History, Geography, Art/Design Technology, Religious Education and PSHE, enriching the curriculum and their learning.

The children have PE sessions on a Thursday afternoon and a Wednesday Morning. Please ensure they bring in their P.E. kit and trainers on those days.

Year 4 go swimming on a Friday afternoon- please ensure swimming kit is fully named.

Homework

Homework is given out every Friday and needs to be in school by the following Friday.

Children will be given a piece of English and Maths homework that is linked to their learning.

The children will be given a set of spellings to learn each week consisting of 8 spellings linked to their taught spellings from the week and an additional two spelling from the National Curriculum Year 3 and 4 spelling words.

They will bring a reading book home. The expectation is to read at least 3 times a week in order to develop fluency and comprehension skills.

Reading record books should be initialed or signed by an adult each time they practise reading at school or at home. This is another helpful tool for regular communication.
