English

This half term we will focus on:

Recounts and Persuasion Texts.

We will also be working on recapping phonics, spelling, punctuation and grammar previously learned and extending into using speech marks and paragraphing.

Computing

Touch Typing -Pupils have developed their touch-typing skills and understand how to touch type using the home, bottom and top row keys using both hands.
