Gulliver returns home.

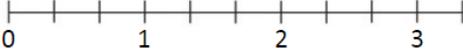
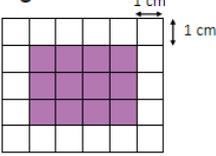
Spelling – We have been working on learning to spell these words in class. Remember there are lots of different activities you can do to help you learn to spell them. Choose a different one for each day you work on them.

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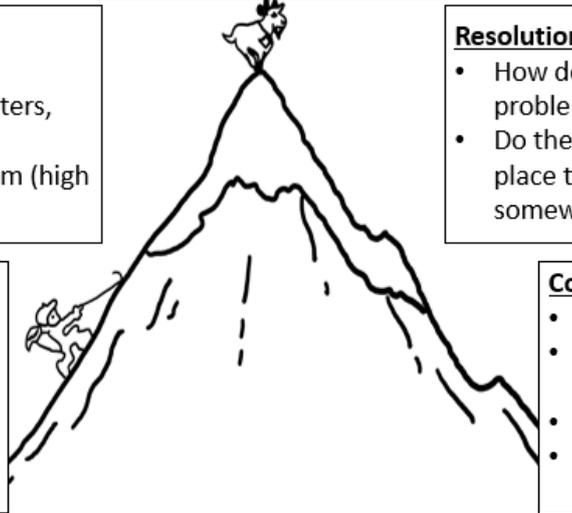
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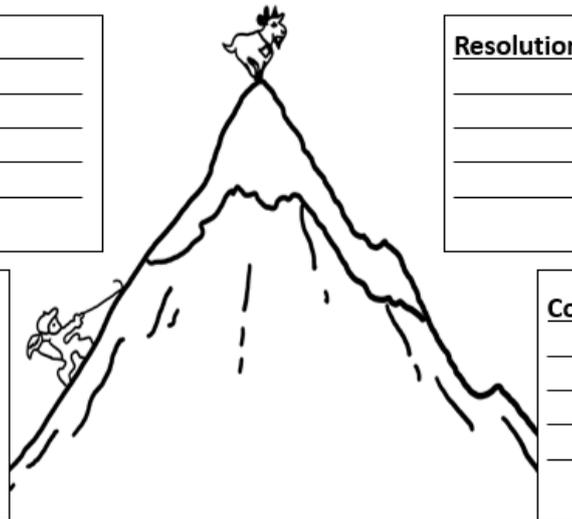
